Discussion Item

a. Public Art Funding Discussion

Charles Hamilton and Jeffrey Mann discussed public art funding ideas. Board members had previously submitted their own ideas review and narrow down options for use of public art funding. The ideas discussed were:

- Maintaining existing collections such as updating framing, weatherproofing, and solar lighting.
- Acquisition of new public art at strategic locations such as progress point, East Morse Blvd., golf courses, old library building re-use, etc.
- Calls for artists, stipends, commission work and artist fees.
- Promote awareness and significance of public art.
 - WP public art app
 - Updating city website about WP PAAB
 - Increase use of high-tech tools and art media
 - Digitize 2-D and 3-D art works such as sidewalk art festival posters to broaden use and visibility, online access, promotion beyond WP; digital art works and art projects; WP public art app, including self-guided walking tour, education/info on individual works, links to public art resources.
- Celebration of new art installations; dedication ceremonies and public events
- Art on the Green type exhibitions and those of that scale.
