Craig O'Neil explained that the objective was to determine which pieces of public art needed to be removed from their current location and staged with a gray museum quality backdrop, and which pieces were okay to be photographed where they were. Craig O'Neil, Theresa Broman, Charles Hamilton, Elizabeth Ingram and Phil Eschbach reviewed the entire list and labeled each one "as is" or "staged" to signify which pieces would be photographed as they were in their current location, or which ones were to be removed and staged in a private room in the Library's archive section. It was determined that 23 pieces would be staged, and 53 pieces would be photographed as they are in their current location.
