Arts Weekend Participation from Public Art Advisory Board

motion | recommendation

The Board is being asked to offer input to the Senior Advisor of Arts & Culture in regard to a possible temporary art installation in Central Park and/or City Hall lawn which will be sponsored by the Public Art Advisory Board.

background

The Arts Weekend subcommittee of the Arts & Culture Alliance is planning all details for the event coming from February 20-23, 2025. The subcommittee requested funding from the PAAB for two items.

1. \$500 for Chalk Art in Central Park to include professional artists creating work on the sidewalks as well as opportunities for children to draw art on the sidewalks with chalk.
2. \$3,000 for a temporary art installation in Central Park and/or City Hall front lawn during the month of February 2025 with the purpose of promoting Arts Weekend and providing opportunities for selfies, etc. on social media. Ideas discussed have included inflatable art similar to the pigeon project currently in downtown Orlando, or something different but eye-catching and discussion provoking to promote Arts Weekend.

The Public Art Advisory Board has approved the expenditure of \$3,500 for these projects at their meeting on August 19, 2024.
