- a. Saturday Market Location and Improvements

Jason Seeley, Parks & Recreation Director, opened the conversation with the most important items pertaining to relocating the market which included parking constraints, farmer's market building rentals, and vendor count limitations. He also briefly reviewed the revenue of the market.

Mr. Seeley stated that he will present both sides of the conversation to the Commission so that vendors and residents alike are equally and fairly represented. Winter Park Fire Department reiterated the occupancy load allowed within the Farmer's Market building and fenced area. Vendor tents, tables, and inventory are deducted

from the allowable occupancy load area calculation.

Mr. Seeley pointed out that the focus should be on how staff reel the market back into what the vendors and residents want it to be. Staff reminded the board that several vendors would have to be cut from the market due to space.

Mr. Seeley clarified what the next steps would be for either improving the current market location or moving the market back to the original location. The board does not want to entertain improving the west meadow for the farmer's market unless it is the last resort; they prefer to move it back to the building.

Saturday Market Location

motion | recommendation

PRAB members are being asked to vote either in favor, or against a recommendation to the City Commission requesting the Saturday Market, currently located at the West Meadow, be returned to its previous location at the Winter Park Farmers Market. Based on survey data and increased operational costs, staff does not support moving the market from the West Meadow back to the Historical Farmers Market location.

background

The Saturday Market was previously located at the Winter Park Farmers Market building and utilized the parking lot along with New England Avenue (from New York to the railroad tracks). During the outbreak of Covid-19, the market was moved to the West Meadow to allow for social distancing.

The move to the West Meadow created a less crowded market venue for both customers and vendors, allowed for the addition of new vendors, while also making the load in and load out process much smoother for the vendors when compared to the Farmers Market location. The change in location also ended the need for a weekly street closure of New England Avenue that required additional staff in order to put in place the necessary barricades (weight of the barriers exceeds 700#).

In 2021, farmers market guests were surveyed over the course of several weeks, with 79.50% of respondents preferring the West Meadow location over the previous location at the Farmers Market building. 381 guests responded to the survey, with 303 preferring the West Meadow to 78 preferring the Farmers Market building location. Additionally, many respondents voiced a desire for new vendors spanning a wide array of products. Full survey results are provided in the attachments.

In late 2024/early 2025, the City surveyed all vendors regarding their preferred location and

other topics relative to the Saturday Market. 66 vendors provided a response to the survey. When asked if they liked the West Meadow location, 92% replied in the affirmative with less than 8% finding the location unsatisfactory. Vendors were also asked if they would want to move back to the previous location (FM building), with over 82% responding in the negative and less than 18% in the affirmative. Of the 66 vendors surveyed, just under 72% (46) of the vendors had also been a vendor when the market was located at its previous location. It is also worth noting that 65% of vendors surveyed experienced an increase in sales at the West Meadow location, with another approximately 22% claiming no change. Only 13% reported a loss of sales since the change in location. Full survey results are provided in the attachments.

At the request of the PRAB, the City once again surveyed Saturday Market guests over the course of 4 weekends that included a Saturday that coincided with the parade with a total of 400 respondents. Of the 400 respondents, 87.6% preferred the West Meadow location to the historical Farmers Market location. 346 in favor of the West Meadow to 49 favoring the FM building location (6 respondents skipped the question). Full survey results are provided in the attachments.

City staff had communicated to PRAB members that a decision to move the market back to the previous location would include a significant increase in operational costs for the City. Members of the board requested the staff provide an overview of projected costs. A more detailed cost projection is provided in the attachments, but in short, the projected annual operating increase in order to relocate the marker to the Farmers Market is estimated at over \$130,000 per year or roughly \$2,600 per week.

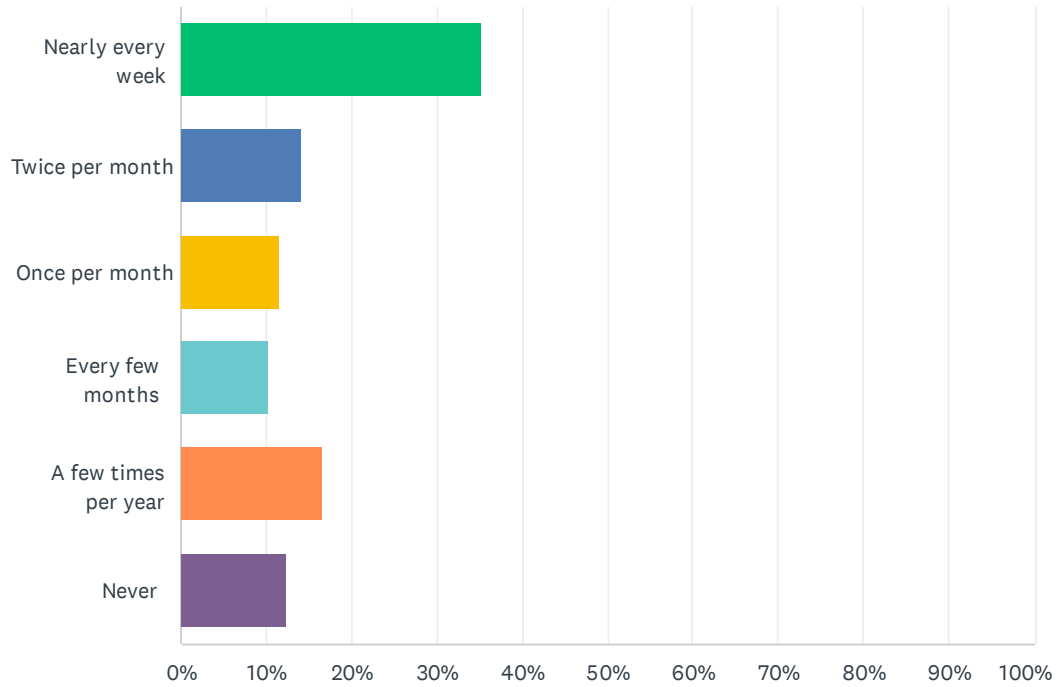
An increase in annual operating expenses of approximately 130,000 along with a loss in revenue earned from vendor fees due to a reduction in available vendor spaces.

Q1 In the past year how frequently have you visited the Saturday Market?

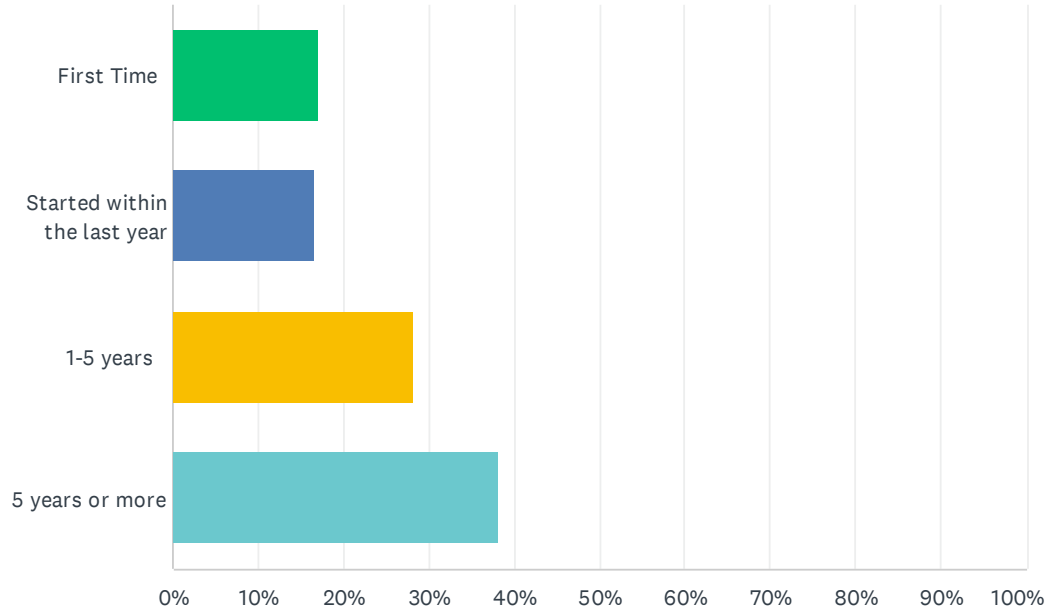

Q2 For approximately how long have you been attending the Winter Park Saturday Market?

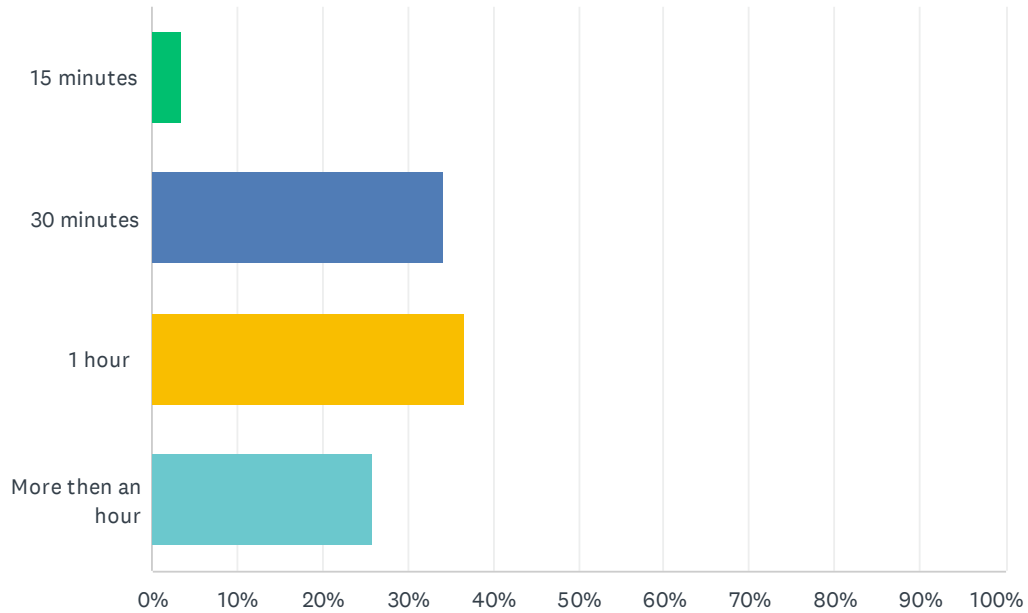

Q3 Approximately, how long do you stay at the Winter Park Saturday Market when shopping?

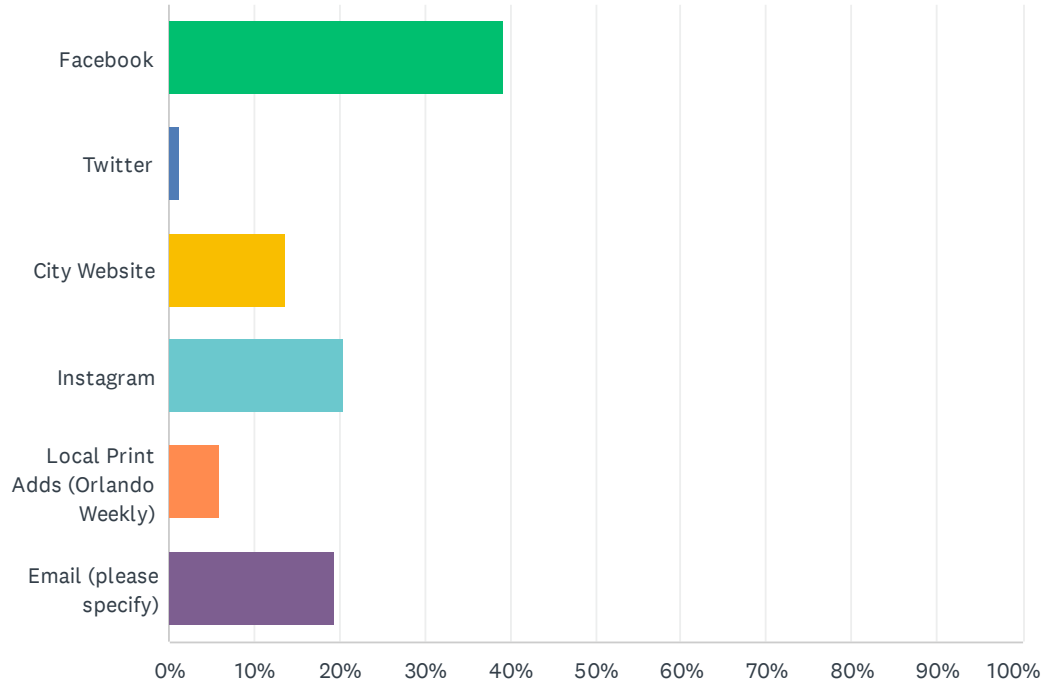

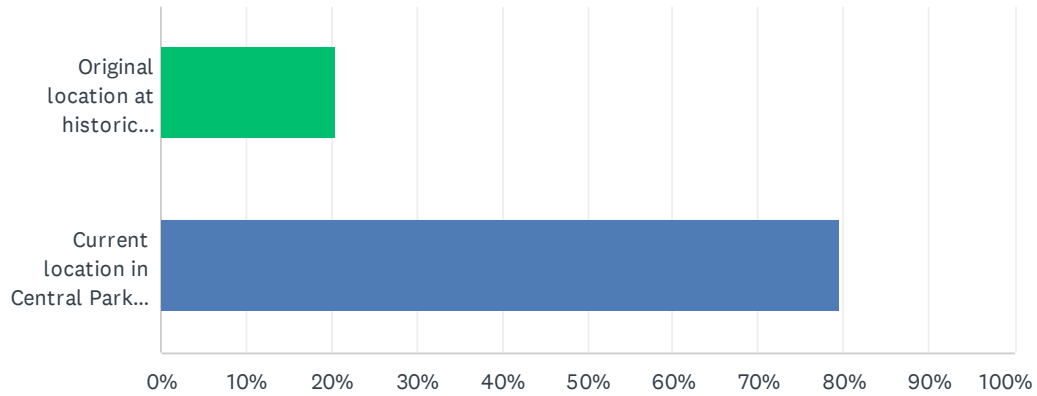

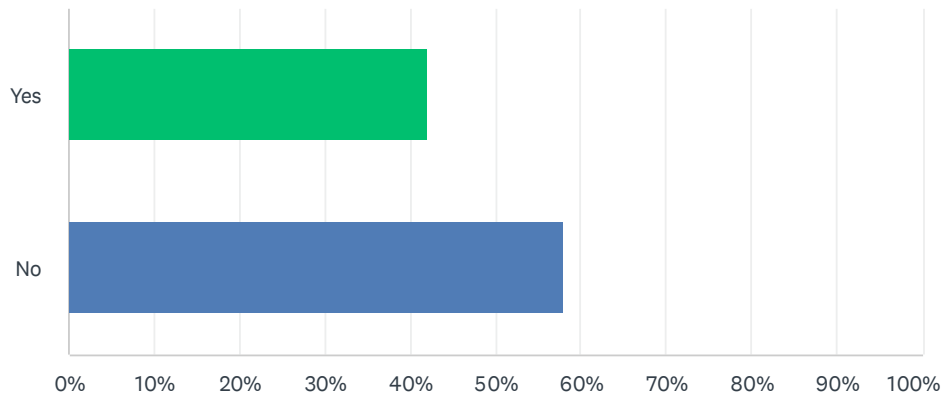

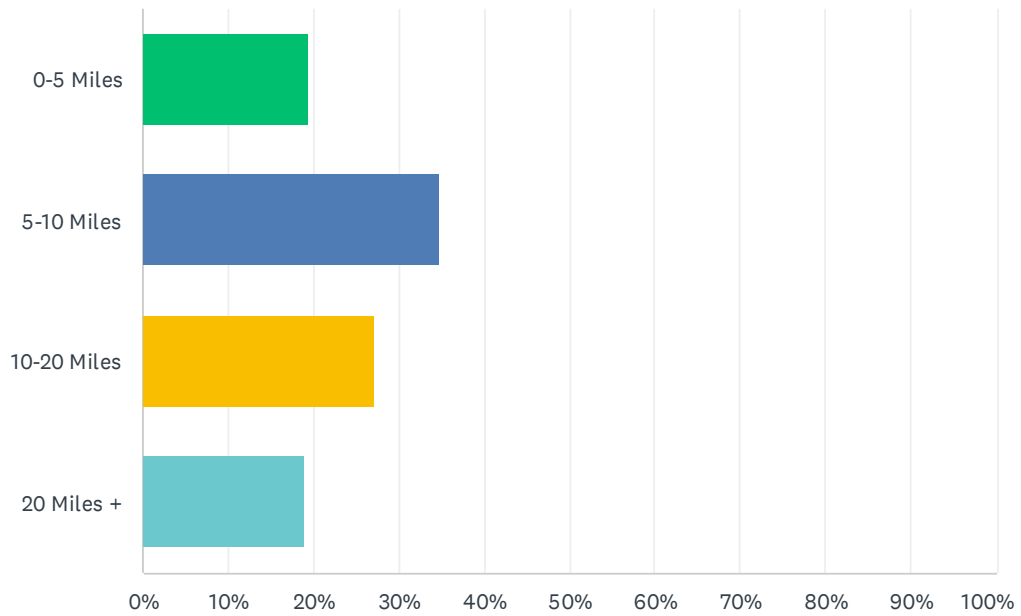

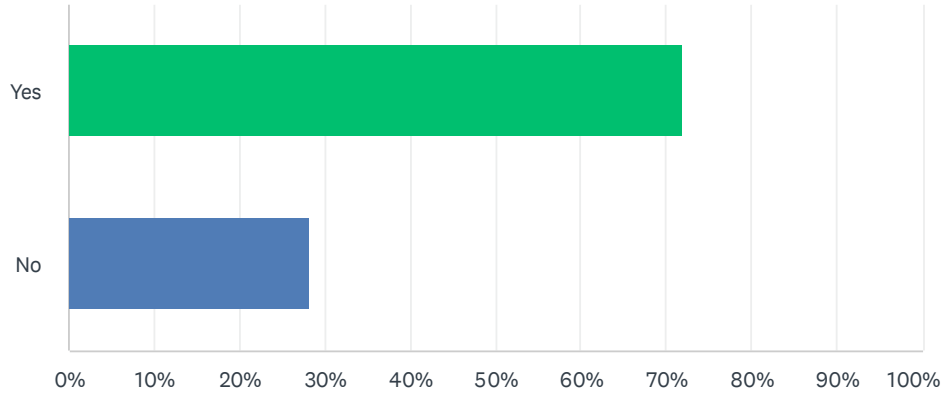

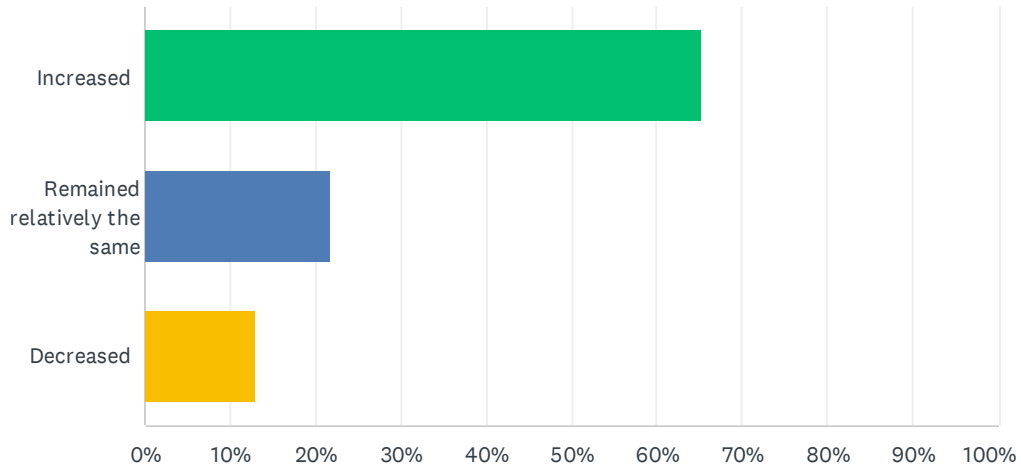

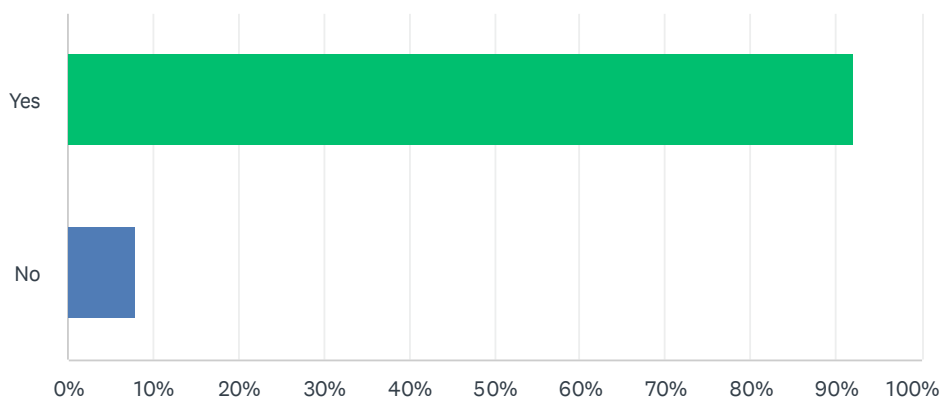

Q5 Do you currently like the location of the Farmers Market?

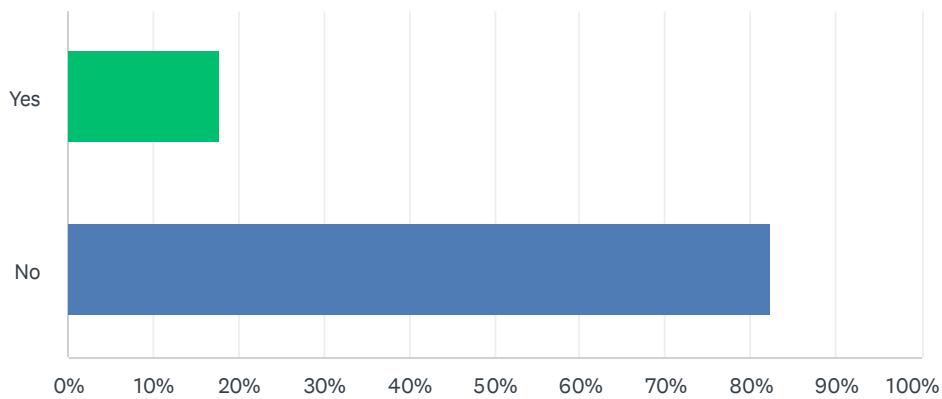

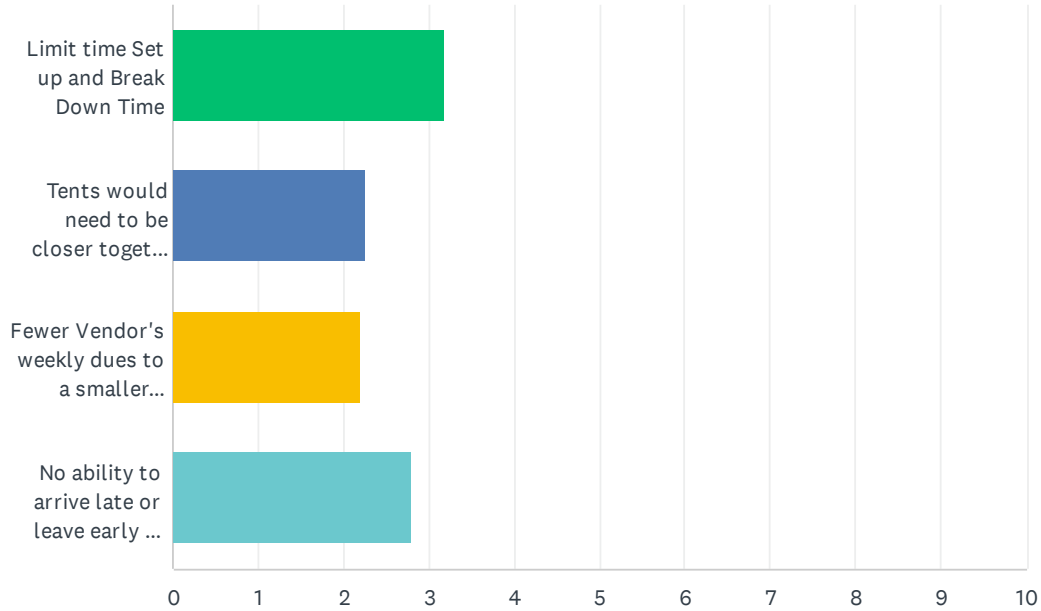

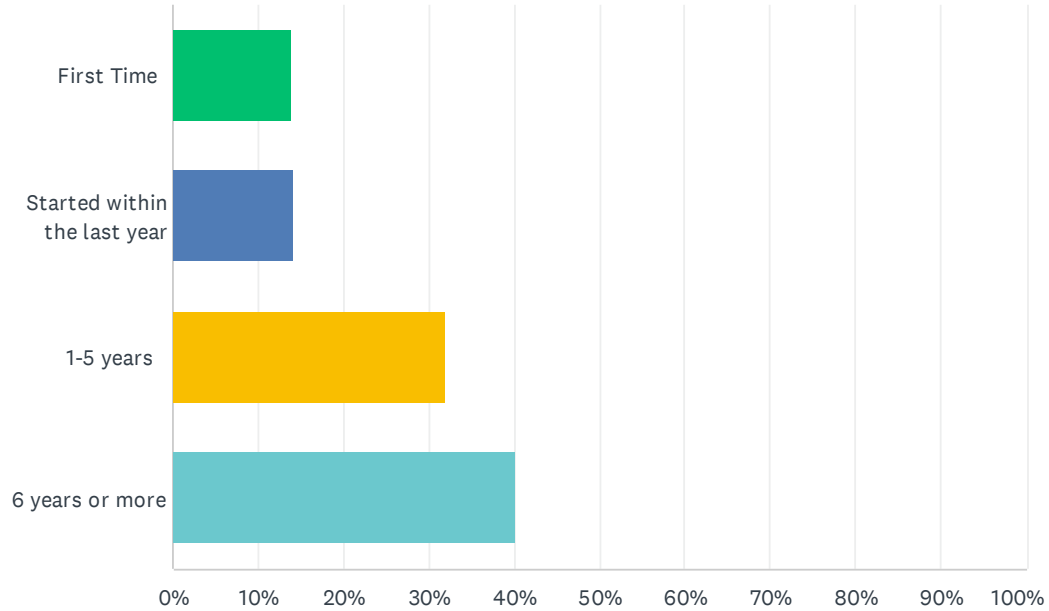

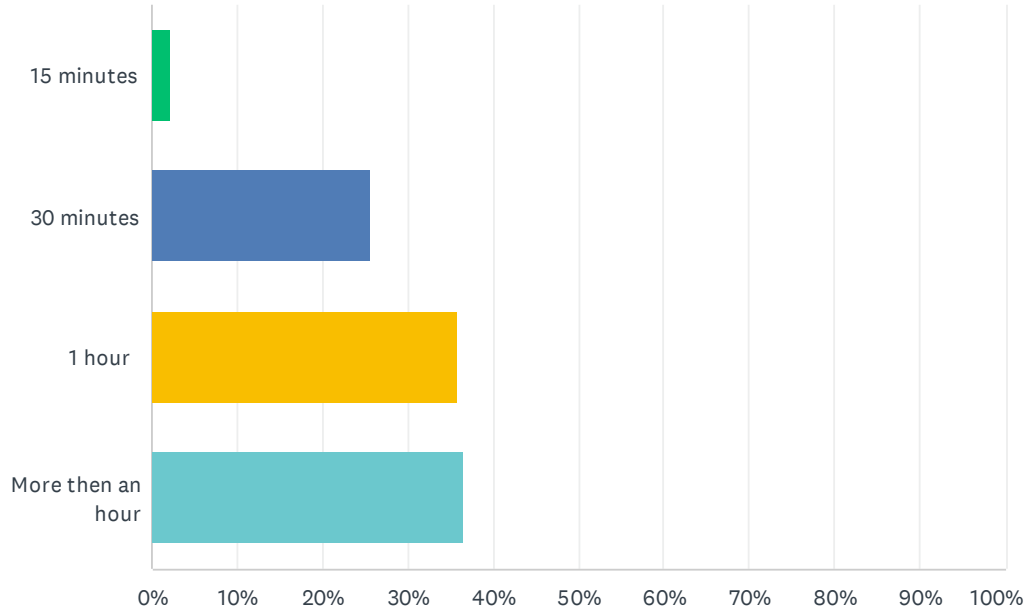

Q3 Approximately, how long do you stay at the Winter Park Saturday Market when shopping?

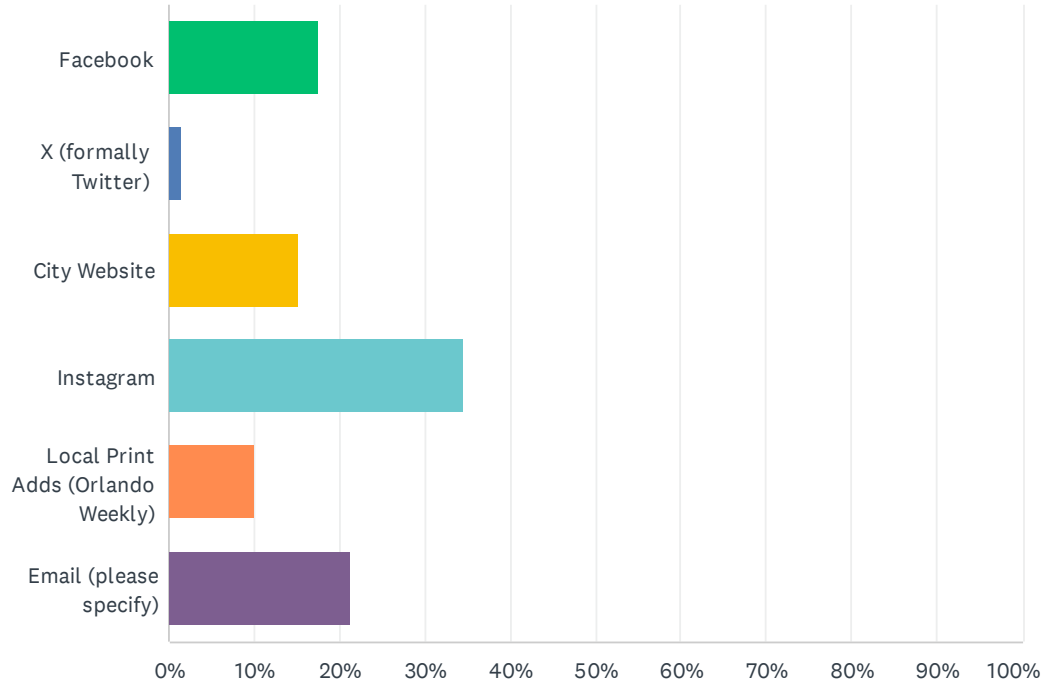

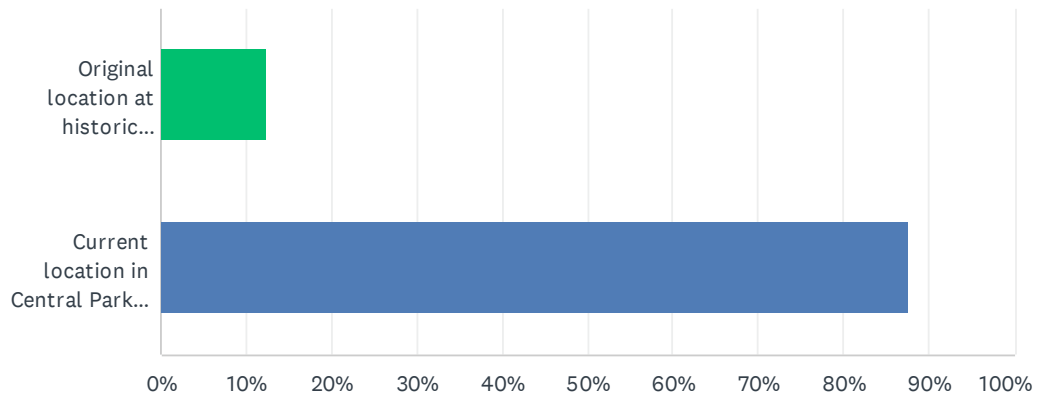

Q8 Which location do you prefer for the Saturday Market?

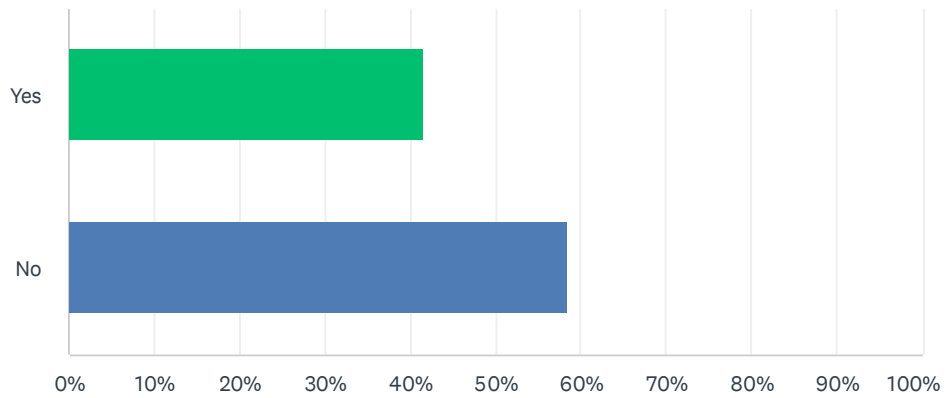

Q9 Are you a Winter Park resident?"

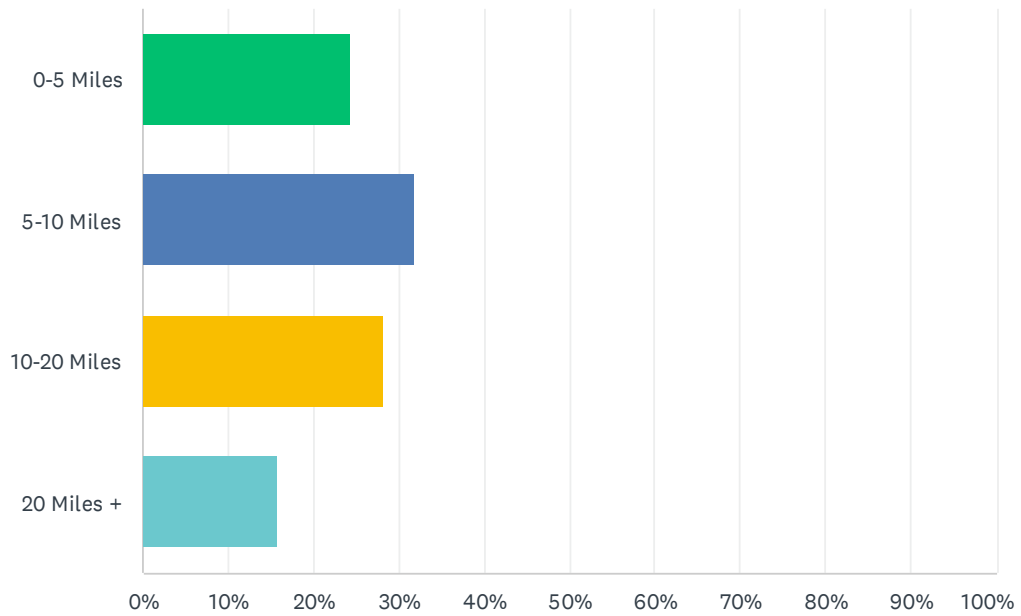
