1. Call to Order

The meeting was called by Chairperson Leah Bonich, at 5:32 pm.

- a. Parks and Recreation Master Plan Introduction

Jason Seeley, Parks & Recreation Director, introduced Kristin Caiborn, GAI Consultants. She provided a brief overview of the process of creating a master plan. She covered the three stages of the process: Project Initiation, Needs Assessment and Framework, and Recommendations and Implementations. GAI will return in August 2026 to provide an update on the information gathered and the progress to date. GAI will host pop-ups at the library where residents and park visitors can voice their concerns and have their inquiries addressed.

Kailyn Haskovec, RRC Research Manager, gave a brief overview of the draft survey. A statistically valid survey will be mailed to 5,000 random City of Winter Park households in mid-March, allowing them to complete it online.

Cathleen Daus, Parks & Recreation Assistant Director, informed board members to submit their feedback to staff by the end of the day on February 23, 2026.

b. Athletic Field Overview and Discussion

Mr. Seeley provided an overview of field usage and rental processes. Aerial views of the fields were presented to the board members to aid in the discussion of the different field types. He noted that winter months are the roughest for the fields and reminded the board that field closures are important and necessary to allow the grass to recover and grow. Field usage and revenue details were included in the agenda packet.

The board inquired about the large field at the 9th-grade center. It was available for use but changed to controlled usage about a decade ago. He would like to know if it could be used in the field rotation. Mr. Seeley stated that administrative changes at the school no longer allowed for city use of the green space.

Discussion continued regarding open-play space opportunities and feasibility at Harland, Phelps, Howell Branch, and Cady Way. Staff believe Cady Way would be the most logical and attainable, as each location poses its own concerns and obstacles.

Phelps Park Rules and Standards

motion | recommendation

Staff is requesting the PRAB members make an interpretation of current rules and standards as they apply to use of the open green space at Phelps Park. The rule in question is the following:

Large open field may not be used for league games/practice.

If PRAB members determine that the type of use currently taking place on the field does not violate the current rules and standards, staff recommends adoption of the provided guidelines as a means to ensure responsible use of the public space and balance use of the public space with quality-of-life concerns from residents living in the parks immediate vicinity. Staff's proposed guidelines for use are provided in agenda item attachments.

If PRAB members determine that the type of use currently taking place on the field violates the current rules and standards, and that such use is not compatible with Phelps Park, then no adoption of the provided guidelines would be necessary. The City would enforce the rule as interpreted by PRAB and require users to vacate the park if conducting such use. In the event that users fail to comply, a trespass warrant will be issued through the City of Winter Park Police Department.

If PRAB members determine that the type of use currently taking place on the field violates the current rules and standards, but use is compatible with Phelps Park, staff would recommend the item be added to a later agenda for board vote once the public input process is conducted and results data provided. Public input would consist of a survey of residents within a quarter mile of the park and a community meeting at the park.

background

During the course of the Winter/Spring youth sports season (January through present), a handful of teams consisting primarily of Winter Park residents living in the vicinity of Phelps

Park, have been using the open space at Phelps Park for flag football practice. From what I have observed personally, and what has been passed along to staff through the park rangers' observation of the park, most, if not all, of this use occurs on Wednesday afternoon from roughly 3 p.m to 5 pm. The teams using Phelps all appear to play in the Under the Lights Flag Football league, which does not conduct any formal or sanctioned practices as part of their league format.

Phelps Park has a rule that came into effect in the late 1990s that prohibited ***league games/practices***. The rule came to be mainly due to youth organizations overtaking the field for their league's use and the parking/noise challenges that came with such. The type of use we are currently experiencing is somewhat different than an organized league overtaking the space for their program and/or operating the field space in such a manner. Present use consists mainly of volunteer coaches who live in the neighborhood coaching their son's or daughter's flag football team using the open space for practice. These practices are not sanctioned by, or have any formal arrangement with a league.

This type of use, which we term low intensity athletic use, is not something we see on our formal athletic fields at MLK or Ward. Most of the organizations that rent our athletic fields run full programs where there are league practice nights with multiple teams, organized and ran by the league itself.

While currently the use of the field for low-impact athletic use of the open space has resulted in only a minor impact on the park and neighborhood, staff has concerns that without some reasonable guidelines for such use the potential for use to become problematic and negatively impact the park and immediate neighborhood could occur. In terms of direct complaints regarding the current use from residents, except for one resident, we have not received any other complaints from residents as of 4/11/26.

1. Use Guidelines for Low Intensity Athletic Use of Phelps Open Space

Use Guidelines for Low Intensity Athletic Use of Phelps Open Space

- Teams may have no more than 15 players
- At least 66 percent of rosters must consist of Winter Park residents.
- No goals, no whistles, and no amplified noise.
- Team practices limited to 12U and younger only.
- A Team is Limited to 1 practice per week.
- Open space is available for low intensity athletic use Tuesday thru Thursday 3p to 6p.
- No more than 2 practices can occur at a time.
- No more than 4 practices per day.
- Practice can be no longer than 90 minutes.
- Team practices only allowed September through May in order for grass to rest and recover.
- Team practice must be conducted in the defined open space area.
- Teams must submit a request and schedule for use through Parks and Recreation Department and are subject to availability on a first come first serve basis.
- All participants must complete a hold harmless that clearly states that the open space is not an official athletic field and use is at their own risk and discretion.

There are many places in Winter Park's parks system that meet the need of just about everyone. Read a book in the quiet beauty of **Kraft Azalea Garden** on Alabama Drive or sit and watch various kinds of boaters at **Dinky Dock Park** on Ollie Street.

For the active, play tennis at **Winter Park Tennis Center** or take a pilates class at the **Community Center** on New England Avenue.



gone fishin'



Fishing is allowed (with a freshwater fishing license) and very popular in most city parks. Lake Mendsen, in **Martin Luther King, Jr. Park** at Denning Drive and Morse Boulevard is a great fishing spot. It is stocked by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission primarily with channel catfish. Largemouth Bass, bluegill, sunfish and blue tilapia can also be found. There is a 14" minimum size for keeping the bass and a five bass limit in this lake. Other species have no size limit and the maximum for keeping is 50 fish.

And don't forget that fishing is also popular at **Dinky Dock Park** and **Kraft Azalea Garden**.

fitness trails



Lake Baldwin Park

Located along a 3-mile path that is used for biking, walking and skating. This path surrounds Lake Baldwin.

Howell Branch Preserve

A 1/5-mile paved path features 10 exercise stations. The park has natural scenery to enjoy on your walk from sunrise to sunset.

Martin Luther King, Jr. Park

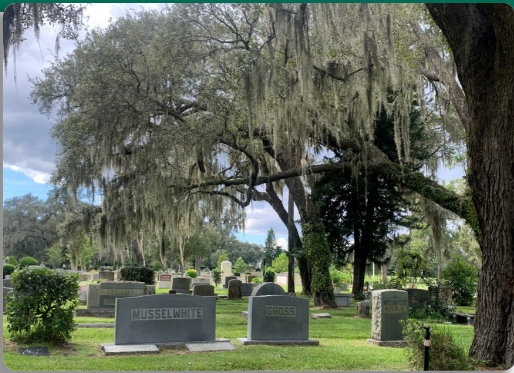
A 1/2-mile walking path nicely decorated and features a fitness area with hydraulic fitness equipment such as cardio stepper, chest and back press, and ab crunch from sunrise to sunset.

Ward Park

A 1/3-mile trail features fitness stations that are geared toward our senior population, but can be used by all ages. Included are a bench stepper, balance station and forearm rolls.

There are two municipal cemeteries that are managed by the Parks & Recreation Department. **Palm Cemetery** is located at New York and Webster avenues and is 17 acres. **Pineywood Cemetery** is located at Lakemont and Glenridge avenues and is 11 acres. With over 18,750 grave spaces in total, these cemeteries have served our community since the late 1800s.

Palm Cemetery

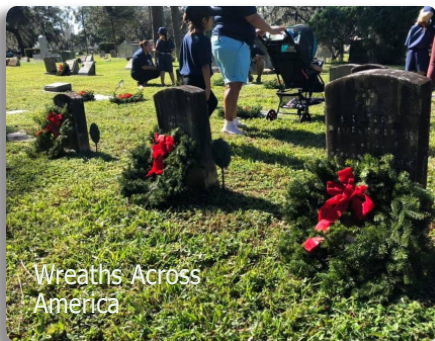
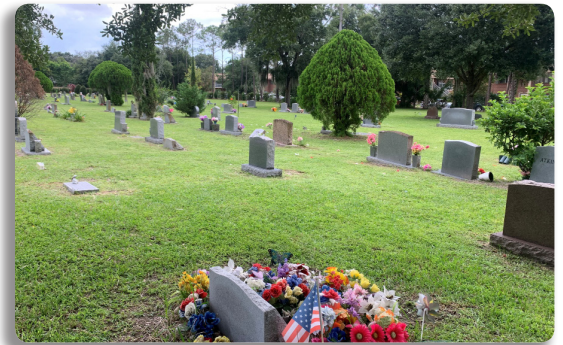
On April 13, 1906, Loring Chase deeded to the city a little over three acres of land to be used specifically as a cemetery. In the agreement, he requested that he be allotted the southeast corner of the cemetery to be used as his plot. On August 24, 1906, he was interred at Palm Cemetery with a marble obelisk over five feet tall as his marker. The inscription memorializes his historical importance to the city as "One of the founders of Winter Park 1881." Palm Cemetery now consists of 17 acres along Webster and New York avenues, bordered by the Winter Park Golf Course.

Pineywood Cemetery

Pineywood Cemetery, originally known as Pinewood Cemetery, was established in February 1890. Although funds started being raised as early as 1884 for the cemetery, the 10 acres along Lake Spier was purchased in 1889 from Dennis Eagan and plotted out by Col. J. H. Abbott.

It was the only cemetery in Winter Park for 17 years until Palm Cemetery was established in 1906. At that time the cemetery was then designated to the residents of Hannibal Square. In May 1946, the Piney Woods association took ownership, and operated and maintained the cemetery until 1970, when the cemetery was deeded back over the city.
